Android Limitations

- Only supported on browsers like Kiwi or Yandex
- Must use responsive layouts
- Some desktop APIs may not work

Performance Constraints

- Smaller CPU
- Limited RAM
- Must keep scripts light and fast

Step 3: Build mobile optimized scripts

Use:

- Small JS bundles
- Efficient DOM manipulation
- Async requests

Step 4: Ensure Android compatibility

Test on:

- Kiwi
- Yandex
- Multiple screen sizes

Step 5: Add a cloud backend

Sync preferences, user data, and actions.

Step 6: Test on real devices

Do not rely only on emulators.
